



## First-Year Experience

- FVSU 0100 (Freshman Seminar)
- Students are required to complete service hours with the iHelp Center.
- Service hours are embedded in the course syllabus.
- By the conclusion of the first semester, each freshmen should have a minimum of 20 service hours.
